In the reference first cited, Government have issued orders for regularisation of Part Time Lecturers working in Aided Degree Colleges stipulating certain conditions. The Regional Joint Director of Higher Education, Rajahmundry has been requested to verify the particulars of Part time Lecturers sent by the Concerned managements and forward the proposals to the Director of Collegiate Education.

The proposals received from the Regional Joint Director of Higher Education have been forwarded to the A.P. College Service Commission for issuing concurrence as required in item 9 of the said G.O. cited.

In the reference 3rd cited, the A.P. College Service Commission forwarded the concurrence of the Part Time Lecturer as shown in the Annexure.

The Director of Collegiate Education, A.P., Hyderabad. hereby orders to regularise the services of (Six) Part time Lecturer(s) as shown in the Annexure as Lecturers and admit him/her/them into grant-in-aid with effect from the date of issue of these orders in the existing aided vacancy.

These Part Time Lecturers who have not passed N.E-1 S.L.E.T. qualifying examination should acquire the same within two years of their regularisation failing which they will be liable for termination.

In view of clause 8 (i) of the G.O. in the reference cited, as the Part Time Lecturer now being regularised may not be in rule of reservation roster the management of the institution concerned shall give an undertaking that it will follow the rule of reservation in future and also will fill up the vacancies as per rule of Communal Roster. If they fail to maintain Communal Roster, they are liable for penal action under provision of U.P. Education Act, 1982 and no grant-in-aid will be released. Further the Managements concerned are informed that they shall maintain communal roster and submit the same to the Regional Director of Higher Education concerned every year for verification that hereafter they will not make any appointments as Part Time Lecturer and that such appointees will not be regularised.

The managements are further informed that in case of regularisation of any person now or earlier ordered, and it is found that such regularisation has been ordered based on incorrect or wrong certificates of service or qualifications or income or any other requirement, orders issued for regularisation of such persons are liable for cancellation besides instituting punitive action against persons responsible for submission of such incorrect information/particulars or wrong certificates.
