Annual Report by Controller of Examinations for the academic year 2019-2020

I am pleased to present the annual report of the college examination section for the academic year 2019-20. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Even semester examinations were postponed, necessitating careful planning and execution to ensure the safety of all students. In adherence to the guidelines prescribed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh, rigorous COVID-19 precautions were implemented throughout the examination process. Despite the unprecedented challenges posed by the pandemic, the college examination section successfully conducted the semester-end examinations while prioritizing the health and well-being of all individuals involved. From 2019 academic year onwards PG autonomy status was granted by Adikavi Nannaya university to our college. In the examination procedure for the first time we introduced OMR answer sheet for PG students.

Conduction of exams –

The examinations for the odd semester were conducted in adherence to the academic calendar. Given the dynamic nature of the pandemic situation, the even semester examinations were flexibly scheduled in the months of September and November. These adjustments were made to suit prevailing conditions while maintaining academic integrity.

UG Odd semester end exams held from -29/10/2019 to 20/11/2019

UG VI semester end exams held from – 21/09/2020 to 10/10/2020

UG II & IV semester exams were held from –20/10/2020 to 31/10/2020

PG Odd semester end exams were held from-28/11/2019 to 06/12/2019

PG even semester end exams were held from- 09/11/2020 to 18/11/2020

Publication of results

The committee members have endorsed and evaluated the results. Utilizing an efficient assessment framework, the results were promptly disclosed within 10-15 days following the conclusion of exams. They were subsequently accessible to students via the college website.

Examination redressal mechanism

After the release of results, a total of 63 students sought revaluation, indicating a commitment to academic excellence. Each request was diligently reviewed and addressed, guaranteeing fairness and adherence to due process. Consequently, 58 students who underwent the revaluation/retotaling process benefited from improved outcomes, affirming the efficacy of our assessment procedures.
