

Annual Report for the Academic Year: 2020-21

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The Annual Report of D.N.R College Autonomous for the academic year 2020-21 along with several development activities is presented.

- ❖ This year we have admitted 1375 students in UG programmes and 347 students in PG programmes and the total admissions are 1722 .
- ❖ We have offered 8 certificated courses in which 200 students have joined.
- ❖ During this year we have continued mentor mentee systems at UG and PG level
- ❖ Out of 1254 students who have appeared to final year exams 945 students were successful in final semester examinations of both UG and PG programmes.
- ❖ Total 874 students are placed in various reputed companies and 122 students opted towards higher education during this academic year.
- ❖ Total 64 faculty members have attended faculty development programs/Seminars/workshops etc. All these 64 Faculty members were provided with financial support for attending conferences, workshops etc. An amount of Rs 1,93,600/- was spent during this year for the above purpose
- ❖ The College has developed rain water harvesting system in the year 2015 and being maintained successfully.
- ❖ College installed STPs and being maintained successfully to recycle used and waste water with a capacity of 24,000 liters. Recycled water is being utilized for watering the gardens.
- ❖ 13 NSS Extension activities were conducted during this academic year
- ❖ Total Number of 06 NCC Extension activities have been conducted during the academic year

- ❖ 269 new courses have been introduced during this academic year.
- ❖ The college has conducted Academic and Administrative Audit, Green Audit, Energy Audit and Environmental Audit with the help of recognized and certified Agency.
- ❖ The college library was updated by acquiring new books and Journals.
- ❖ The college maintains strict student discipline in the campus. CC Cameras were installed at various critical points.
- ❖ An active Women Empowerment cell is working in the college to take care of the welfare of girl students and lady staff members.
- ❖ Due to covid-19 class work was highly disturbed both for UG and PG, to compensate this, online classes were conducted. Examinations were conducted by taking all the precautions as per Covid protocol norms
- ❖ Board of studies meetings and Academic council meeting were conducted online.
