Conduct of Seminars:

The department of Commerce has conducted one day national seminar on the topic "Demonetization-The Philosophy, Practice and Problems" utilizing UGC's Autonomous Grant with the collaboration of Bank of India.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC):

The IQAC cell has been setup with 9 members as per the UGC guidelines to implement the quality policy of the college and to bring about continuous improvement in teaching-learning processes and related administrative mechanisms. It includes two eminent external experts as members. Quality circles are constituted by IQAC from time to time for identifying solutions and implementing action plans. #### Career Guidance Cell:

The Career Guidance Cell of our college has organized coaching classes for Nannaya Cet-2017 and ICET-2017 immediately after the VI Semester Exams are over. Help desks were also arranged to guide and assist the students who wish to join Post Graduate courses.

#### Placements:

The placement cell of our college remains a boon to the final year Degree students who are going to leave the campus with Certificate for his/her qualification and an offer letter for employment. The main motto of our college management and the faculty is to prepare the student to face any written test and other screening tests in the process of searching for their employment.
